1. PAC-B Committee Chair Annual Report, David Andrus
 - I. This item was pulled.
2. Academic Senate Presidents Report, David Andrus
 - i. **ASCCC Update – Fall 2023 Area C Meeting (pg. 9-11):** There is much work on DEIA, Common Course Numbering, CalGETC and Vision 2030. The Common Course Numbering deadline is likely to be extended to July 1st of 2027, but that is not yet official. Area C reviewed the packet of resolutions.
 - ii. **Association of CBO’s Conference:** David Andrus, Sharleen Coleal and Jason Hinkle attended the ACBO conference in Santa Barbara. A presentation on the new budgetary tool built by Jason was shared by David, Jason and Sharlene.
 - iii. **Dept. Chair Training: 3rd session:** Next session is for Nov. 17th from 10:00 am – 12pm and will be run by Miriam Golbert and Omar Torres. It will be held in Mentry 343 only. There is no Zoom option for this particular workshop.
