

BP 2200 Board Duties and Responsibilities

Reference:

Accreditation Standard 4 Education Code Section 70902

- 1. The Board of Trustees governs on behalf of the citizens of the Santa Clarita Community College District in accordance with the authority granted and duties defined in Education Code Section 70902.
- 2. The Board is committed to fulfilling its responsibilities to:
 - a. Represent the public interest
 - b. Establish policies that define the institutional mission and set prudent, ethical and legal standards for college operations
 - c. Establish and maintain policies that the District will operate in an anti-racist manner.
 - d. Hire and evaluate the CEO
 - e. Delegate power and authority to the chief executive to effectively lead the district
 - f. Assure fiscal health and stability
 - g. Monitor institutional performance and educational quality
 - h. Advocate and protect the district
 - i. Conduct itself in a manner consistent with Accreditation Standards
 - j. Represent the District in the SCV Community and at the State level as needed.
- 3. The Board of Trustees will review and approve performance indicators, on an annual basis, or as required by mandates or regulations.
