

AP 3500 Campus Safety

1. Planning

A campus safety plan shall be developed and provided to students and the campus community.

2. Reporting

- a. The Director of Campus Safety prepares an annual security update report that includes the number of occurrences reported to Campus Safety of, and arrests for, crimes that are committed on campus and that involve stalking, violence, hate violence, theft or destruction of property, illegal drugs, or alcohol intoxication, and of all occurrences of noncriminal acts of hate violence reported to campus authorities. The Annual Security report will be posted on the Campus Safety web site.
- b. Written records of noncriminal acts of hate violence shall include at least a description of the act of hate violence, the victim characteristics, and offender characteristics, if known.

3. Posting

- a. The Campus Safety Plan is updated annually and posted on the Campus Safety website.
- b. The Annual Security Report is updated in October of every year and is posted on the Campus Safety website and available in the Campus Safety office on both the Valencia and Canyon Country Campuses.
