



AP 5535 Student Participation in Collegial Consultation

California Code of Regulations, Title 5 51023.7

1. Procedures for student participation collegial consultation

- A. The appointment of student representatives to serve on college or district committees, task forces, or other governance groups, shall be made by the president of the Associated Student Government of College of the Canyons acting on behalf of the Associated Student Government.
- B. The selection of the Student Trustee to serve as a non-voting member of the Santa Clarita Community College District Board of Trustees shall be conducted according to the provisions established by the California Education Code, Santa Clarita Community College District Board Policies, and the Constitution of the Associated Students of College of the Canyons.
- C. Persons who are appointed to committees have the responsibility to represent their constituencies via attendance at meetings, and communication of committee discussion and decisions back to the Associated Student Government.

2. Scope of Regulations

Nothing in this section shall be construed to impinge upon the due process rights of faculty, nor to detract from any negotiations or negotiated agreements between collective bargaining agents and the district governing board.
