

BP 5053 Assessment

- 5053.1 Assessment is the process that combines the administration of assessment instruments with additional measures to determine student skill set levels in computational and language skills, assist students in identifying their aptitudes, interests and educational objectives, evaluate students' study and learning skills, and other factors that support their efforts to meet their educational objectives.
- 5053.2 All new students entering College of the Canyons will be required to participate in the assessment component of the Student Success and Support Program (SSSP) unless exempted from this requirement according to the criteria listed in AP 5053. Students who meet criteria for an assessment exemption may still choose to assess, particularly if they are attempting to enroll in any course with an unfulfilled prerequisite. It is the responsibility of the student to request an exemption from the assessments and to submit the appropriate corresponding evidence.
