

BP 6250 Budget Management

Title 5 Sections 58307 and 58308

- 1. The budget shall be managed in accordance with Title 5 and the California Community Colleges Budget and Accounting Manual. Budget revisions shall be made only in accordance with these policies and as provided by law.
- 2. The District's shall strive to maintain unrestricted general reserves of no less than 16.7% of the total budget. **NOTE:** The Government Finance Officers Association and the California Community Colleges Chancellor's Office recommended that unrestricted reserves comprise <u>a minimum</u> of two months of expenditures.
- 3. Revenues accruing to the District in excess of amounts budgeted shall be added to the District's reserve for contingencies. They are available for appropriation only upon a resolution of the Board that sets forth the need according to major budget classifications in accordance with applicable law.
- 4. Board approval is required for changes between major expenditure classifications. Transfers from the reserve for contingencies to any expenditure classification must be approved by a two-thirds vote of the members of the Board. Transfers between expenditure classifications must be approved by a majority vote of the members of the Board.
