Our Aerospace & Science student team is in full swing as Spring begins: HASP 2023

Submitted proposal on January 6 for 2023 NASA HASP mission.

RockSatX 2023

Students have continued to work through the break, prototyping and working on our next NASA deliverable due in February which is a "Sub-System Tests Reveiw" where we must demonstrate that all individual sub-systems like our flight computer and capsule ejection systems are functioning.

RockOn 2023

The 2023 mission will be in person this year. Students will build and test their payload during a 1-week interactive workshop at NASA Wallops and then observe it launch on a sounding rocket and retrieve their payload for analysis.

GLEE 2024

Our team is working on the mini-payload that will go to the moon aboard Artemis in 2024 and contirbute to the knowledge base needed for inhabiting the moon.

Graduates are now in the process of obtaining their **Security Clearance** so they can work on highly classified programs.






Grants Development

Grants Development, under Director Amber Cole, continues to collaborate with many partners to support program needs and strategic goals.

Recent office highlights include:

- \$14,409,050 secured to-date for FY22/23, not including more than \$5M in appropriations requests also supported by the Office.
- **Recent award**:
 - \$260K for developing a new UAA
 Robotics Program
- \$10 million in pending grant awards.



LA Care Health Plan Grant Award for 2023 CalFresh Outreach



College of the Canyons was awarded **\$145,000** to provide **CalFresh** outreach and application assistance. This grant will run from *January 1st, 2023 to December 31st, 2023*. The funding will be used to expand upon existing CalFresh services offered through COC. Specific uses for this money:

- Hiring additional short-term employees and students who can serve as ambassadors and expand program outreach to Canyon Country Campus.
- > Increasing visibility to local formers markets where their CalFresh can be used and matched.
- Hosting Webinars for students taught by staff to help answer myths regarding eligibility requirements.
- Sending out informational flyers and marketing materials about CalFresh to community members
- Conduct **outreach to low-income families**, students already receiving fee waivers and Pell grants.

COC Receives \$25,000 Stanley Black & Decker Grant

College of the Canyons has received a **\$25,000** grant through **Stanley Black & Decker's** second **Global Impact Challenge** to provide support to students enrolled in the college's new Construction Technology pathway.

- As a Makers grant recipient, COC is among 91 organizations that will help skill and reskill roughly 210,448 makers throughout 2023.
- The grant will allow us to hire a pre-construction technology lab technician to increase the likelihood of student completion and career success.
- The pre-construction technology lab technician will work onsite to provide 50 COC students with one-on-one attention, additional instruction, and mentorship support.





\$5.3 Million in Federal Funding

COC has been awarded **\$5.3** million dollars in federal earmark appropriations for the following programs.

- \$2 Million: To provide equipment and technician training for new Advanced Technology Center.
- \$1 Million for a new ATC Robotics Lab, which will be located in the new Advanced Technology Center
- \$2.3 Million Fire Academy to fund an Apparatus and associated equipment for the new Accredited Regional Training Program.




ETI Partners with Stay Green

AAC&U Annual Meeting RECLAIMING LIBERAL EDUCATION January 18–20, 2023 • San Francisco, CA

Patty Robinson represented COC at the 2023 AAC&U Annual Meeting this month by participating in two sessions where she:

- First, discussed findings, concerns, and recommendations, joined by colleagues from the *Kettering Foundation* and *LEAD California*, addressing the civic mission of CCCs from her recent sabbatical project.
- Second, reflected upon preliminary observations of findings from COC's participation in AAC&U's nationwide Civic Engagement Rubric Project.



Canyon Country Campus Update

- Staff have begun moving in to the new Student Services & Learning Resources on campus and continue to setup the offices and functions to serve students. Many thanks to Facilities, Business Services, and Computer Support in particular for supporting the exciting but complicated logistics.



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COVID 19 Update

Coronavirus Update Recent Highlights







- National COVID-19 community levels are low-to-medium with some winter season surges:
 - 63% of counties are "low," 31% are "medium," and 6% of counties are in a "high" transmission level as of 1/24.
 - LA County is in the **low** transmission category since 1/20. Masks are recommended by DPH in indoor settings, and county metrics and hospitalization rates are monitored to inform guidance.
- Statewide, there are 10 cases per 100k with a 6.1% positivity rate, decreased from 13.1 per 100k with a 10.8% positivity as of 12/1. (CDC weekly rate: 78.2 as of 1/24.)
- Countywide, LA County averaged 11.6 cases per 100K and 5.3% positivity rate as of 1/24, decreased from 17.1 cases and 11.5% positivity as of 12/1. (CDC weekly rate: 93.3 as of 1/24.)
- LA County DPH Health Order: The most recent DPH update was 9/22. The College continues to follow developments, maintaining a COVID-19 Containment, Response, and Control Plan online.

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
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COC Road to Employment Day


The Spring 2023 Professional Development/FLEX Week is just around the corner! January 30th – February 3rd




Silver Spur Coming Up
