


# COC Stands Out

# **Athletics Update**

### Men's Golf

- ➤ Canyons remains undefeated in **Western State Conference (WSC)** play after shooting a five-man score of **363** at the conference event hosted by Allan Hancock College on Monday.
- All four scoring golfers finished their round in the 70s, with sophomores Kieran Bye and Dom De Luca shooting a two-under-par round of 70 to share medalist honors with a third player.
- > The Cougars are gunning for their **12**th straight WSC title in 2023.

### **Swim & Dive**

- Canyons saw its men's team finish runner-up at WSC, meet No. 1 hosted by Allan Hancock College on Feb. 17<sup>th</sup>, representing the Cougars' best finish at a conference meet since 2019. The women's team finished **fift**h at the meet.
- The Cougars finished first in three events with freshman Christian Cruz taking the top spot in both the 50-yard freestyle (23.78) and 100-yard backstroke.
- ➤ COC is back in the water March 9-11 at the 44<sup>th</sup> Annual Cuesta College Invite.









# **Spring 2023 CougarFest**

CougarFest returned to the Valencia campus Monday, Feb. 13<sup>th</sup>, and the Canyon Country campus Thursday, Feb. 16<sup>th</sup>.

- ➤ 400+ students were connected to our 35 departments/programs and 16 clubs/alliances between both events.
- ➤ **188** Jersey Mike sandwiches, **125** Regal movie tickets and over **100** COC tote bags were given to participating students who visited a certain amount of tables.
- A mother and COC adjunct faculty member shared that her son came home all excited after he and his friends had fun attending CougarFest. He said he got free food and even spoke with a counselor. She said they all loved it and shared how this is making a difference for our students.

- Keep an eye out for future openings.










# **Coronavirus Update Recent Highlights**



- National COVID-19 community transmission levels are low, decreased from last month:
  - 82% of counties are "low," 16% are "medium," and 2% of counties are "high" transmission level as of 3/3.
  - LA County is in the low transmission category since 1/20.
- ➤ Statewide, there are 6.9 cases per 100k with a 6.5% positivity rate as of 3/3, slightly increased from 6.1 cases per 100k and 5.0% positivity as of 2/6.
- Countywide, LA County averaged 7.3 cases per 100K and 5.2% positivity rate as of 3/3, slightly increased from 6.9 cases and 3.7% positivity as of 2/6.
  - LA County's Board of Supervisors will end the local COVID-19 emergency at the end of March.
  - The most recent LA County DPH Health Order was 9/22 with updates anticipated soon.







# **Civic Dialogues Are Back!**
