



RockSat-X Soars

NASA's **RockSat-X** rocket launched from Wallops Flight Facility in Virginia on **Thursday, Aug. 11**th, carrying a science payload designed by College of the Canyons students.

- It was the *Aerospace & Sciences Team's* second NASA rocket launch this summer.
- After soaring to 91 miles altitude, RockSat-X's payload with experiments from eight colleges descended by parachute and splashed down in the Atlantic Ocean some 64 miles off the Virginia coast.
- ➤ RockSat-X is the most advanced of NASA's three-phase rocket research program for college students. The Aerospace & Sciences Team's focus now shifts to NASA's High-Altitude Student Platform (HASP) project, which is *scheduled to launch* **Tuesday**, **Sept. 6**th. The science payload will be carried into the upper stratosphere on a high-altitude research balloon.

New Trainings for Our Workforce!



New ETP Sub-Contract with Logix Federal Credit Union

The **Employee Training Institute** launched an ETP Sub-Contract Agreement with Logix to supplement the training they already provide to their employees.

- They are the *first* Credit Union to obtain ETP approval for COC.
- ➤ 15 new hires are participating in over 90 hours of training.
- ➤ We are now planning additional cohorts to partake in the ETP Sub-Contract.





New ETP Sub-Contract: Western Jet Aviation

Western Jet Aviation developed their own Aircraft Maintenance Training program and have partnered with ETI to create an ETP-Sub Contracting Agreement.

- The pilot cohort consists of **12** employees taking over 400 hours of training.
- ➤ 200 hours will be covered under ETP and the remaining hours will be covered by Incumbent Worker Training (IWT) funds that the AJCC administers.
- ➤ We are now planning additional cohorts to partake in the ETP Sub-Contract.






New ETP Training: City of Santa Clarita

- This is the *first* time the City of Santa Clarita has been eligible to use ETP funding.










The Canyon Country Campus Celebrates 15 Years!






Classified Senate Donut Drop


Today, the **Classified Senate** held a **Donut Drop** event at both campuses.

Coronavirus Update Recent Highlights







- > National COVID-19 community levels are low-to-medium according to the CDC.
 - 43% are "low," 40% are "medium," and only 17% of counties are in the "high" transmission level.
 - LA County is in the low transmission category as of 9/13.
- > Statewide, there are 15.8 cases per 100k with a 7.8% positivity rate as of 9/9, significantly decreased from 40.7 cases per 100k and 14.5% positivity as of 8/3.
- Countywide, LA County averaged 17.9 cases per 100K and a 7.4% positivity rate as of 9/9, significantly decreased from 49.9 cases per 100K and 12.6% positivity as of 8/2.
- The current LA County DPH Health Order is continued from 4/21 with conditions generally improving including a decrease in hospitalizations.
- The College continues to follows the latest developments and maintains a COVID 19 Containment, Response, and Control Plan online.

- Effective April 15, this revision significantly expanded the number of people considered to be exposed, and changed how the College reports COVID-19 exposures.




2022/23 PAC Seaon on Sale Now

The event is scheduled **10 a.m. to 1 p.m.** in the outdoor area between Canyons Hall and the Student Center.


Hispanic Heritage Month Celebration
