- Food Committee: (Jonna Kelly)
 - The committee met recently. Ethan the owner of the Coffee Kiosk did briefly open, however, there was not enough traffic and the coffee kiosk was closed down again. Ed in Cougar Café has retired. There are no plans to have a full return for fall for food. There was a recent food vendor event at CCC. There were 22 vendors who expressed interest, but little follow-through. ISSI is interested in offering vegan options. Any food recommendations can be sent to Joanna.
- CPT: (Yarely Gonzalez) There is a need for more classified staff on this committee. CPT recently worked on the mission statement.
- CPC: A recent policy was passed which is the AP 3910, Time, Place & Manner. This policy allows the Classified Senate to publish letters without censorship.
- Enrollment Management: (Vida Manzo)
 - The meeting focused on the Student-Centered Funding Formula and on Supplemental Allocation. Outreach from Financial Aid has been maintained. There has been a decline in overall enrollment. District has

been given an emergency allowance; this will not impact the colleges funding.
