- 1) Will be reaching out to Michelle Foster in the Spring semester to see if she would be willing to be a student panelist at our 2nd February meeting. She mentioned her schedule may be able to accommodate.
- 2) Clinton Slaughter, who is the Dean of Counseling and Daylene, who works in our Dean for the Institutional Research Department reached out to me asking to learn more about Canyons Cares and to understand how Canyons Cares can be possibly integrated into the Student Success Teams. There has been discussion especially in IE2 about a College Concierge where any door that any student walks in is the correct one. My initial concern is that across the board, classified staff on average are already overworked and in some departments understaffed as is. If Canyons Cares were to participate or be designated as a Student Success Team, the goal would be to see how that would be feasible. Obviously, we wouldn't want Classified staff to be given more work in helping with this and the other question is how we would incentivize staff. There was no response from Clinton or Daylene, so we are unsure if they still want to pursue this. Michael said he would check with Clinton if they are still interested.
