PR – Program Review changes for 2020-21</p>	<p>In 2020-21 the following changes will be implemented to the PR module:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Program SLOs descriptions will be updated and formatted to fit into one box - The Resources Invested table: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> o Renamed to “5 Year Trend” where previous year will be dropped as another is added to keep it at a 5 year total. o Will include a hyperlink would lead to where the data for the data trends is posted. Resources and requirements, for providing data for job placement rates, will be identified o In the interim, Norris will be updating/entering data in the table, based on a template form that will be filled out by the chairs and attached to the PR at the end of the year. The template will be an excel sheet o Data that can be pre-populated in the table, will be identified. - Facilities and Technology Needs will contain items that were duplicates somewhere else. - Staffing forms will be updated with the long term goal, that by the next full cycle, they will be included in the PR editable format. - The Educational Facility Master-Plan goals will be pre-listed by program/department to include just that program’s department goals. - Jim Temple will provide information for the timeline of the implementation of all the 2020-21 changes. <p>Training for the data coaches will provide faculty with assistance in reviewing their PR data and making the connections to support the process.</p>

CASL: Data Coaches for SLO Assessment and Evaluation</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Define Role for SLOs • Areas of Need 	<p>The data coaches can help the faculty answer the following questions as they relate to the SLO assessments data:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - How to find the data? - What do the numbers mean (what is the significance?) - How to address the identified need, whether it is a classroom, department or institution? - How does overlapping of the disaggregation of data, fit in the identified need? - Can we have disaggregation reports based on course/section modalities (online, hybrid vs in person) <p>The committee members are invited to attend the data coaches training on September 27th 2019 from 9 to 11 in BONELLI 106. The committee members will be sharing their course, department assessment data to help toward creating exercises for the data courses.</p> <p>Meeting with the Center for Education Teaching and Learning Educators will be held to train and pass the baton to faculty for classroom issues identified through the data.</p>		
<p>4. CASL – Insights into Performance Report for 2019 Data Disaggregation of Data</p>	<p>Evis Wilson presented the steps to running SLO Performance reports for courses that were assessed in 2019.</p> <p>eLumen users in the roles of Data Steward, Course Coordinator, and Department Coordinators, can run SLO Performance reports from the Reports module/tab in eLumen.</p> <p>Current issues that are being addressed regarding the disaggregation reports of Course SLOs:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Masking data points to comply with FERPA and California Regulations - Running reports for course series to track progress over the term or across term - Running reports for disaggregating data by course modalities 	<p>Evis Wilson to assist in forwarding the invitation to the 9.27.2019 Data Coaches training meeting to the CASL-PR members</p>	

<p>5. CASL – Mapping and Assessment of PSLOs</p>	<p>Program SLOs and their mapping source (CSLOS), are found under the SLOs and Assessments tab in eLumen. Course Coordinators, Department Coordinators and Data Stewards have access to that module/tab.</p> <p>PSLOs assessments are implied through the assessment of CSLOs that are mapped to those PSLOs.</p> <p>PSLOs assessment should be complete by Spring 2020.</p>		
<p>6. CASL – Next Steps Mapping Information Literacy to ISLO</p>	<p>The next step in the ISLO assessments, is to set up a date for the group of faculty who assessed the Information Literary ISLO in the Spring 2019, to discuss, analyze assessment results and close the loop on that assessment.</p>
