NEW COURSE PROPOSALS – DISCUSSION OF NEED

The following new course proposals will be discussed at this meeting with the authors of the proposals to determine the need of adding the course to our curriculum.
The course outlines will not be reviewed at this meeting.

Subject & Number	Title	Rationale for New Course Proposal	Author	Effective
BIOSCI-101	General Biology for Health Professions	The current Bio 100 serves as both a GE course and a prerequisite course for A&P and Microbiology. During the last 5-year curriculum revision, the Biology dept. attempted to include more A&P and Microbiology topics into Bio 100 in order to better serve as a prerequisite class. However, it has become clear to all faculty teaching Bio 100 in this revised format for several years, that it's not possible to meet the needs of both groups of students effectively with such a broad course outline. COC IRPIE research analysis (RB#216) suggests that two different general biology courses would be appropriate to serve the GE population and the Allied Health majors separately. In the attached proposed Bio 101 COR, we have highlighted the topics that would be unique to Bio 101 and would take up approximately the last third of the semester in lab and lecture. It would not be possible to simply revise the existing Bio 100 to incorporate and cover these topics without removing a substantial number of important topics that could affect the articulation of the existing Bio 100 course with other colleges.
