Subject & Number	Title	Rationale for New Course Proposal	Author	Effective
ANTHRO-120	Queer Anthropology – Global Perspective	Cross-cultural exploration of gender and sexual identities and expressions that would be considered atypical from a Euro-American standpoint. The goal is to introduce students to the dizzying variety of ways in which gender and sexuality are and have been constructed in human societies, presently and in the very recent past, in order to help them develop an expansive understanding of human gender diversity. This course articulates with the goals and approaches of other courses in Anthropology and Sociology but fills a gap in both. Anthropology has courses that focus on cross-cultural understandings of various topics, but not one focused on gender and sexuality.
