
Canvas post to 73 sections with a total of 1,937 students enrolled.

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Demographics of Survey Respondents







Last English Class and Perception of Preparedness for ENGL-101




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




Perceptions of 'Preparedness' by 'Rigor level'

Q: In this course, did you learn to reflect on how you read, write, and think (also called thinking-about-thinking/metacognition)?





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

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Q: Which of the following applies to how you completed your reading assignments for this course?






Q: How valuable/helpful was the embedded tutor in your class?






