

CANYON COUNTRY CAMPUS

The Canyon Country Campus (CCC) is a comprehensive campus, providing a full array of services befitting a site that is larger than several small college districts in California. Since 2007, more than 65,000 different students have earned course credit here and more than 7,600 classes have been offered. The campus has expanded access to higher education in the Santa Clarita Valley with approximately 18 associate degree offerings and 13 certificate programs that can be completed on site. The campus traditionally offers more than 100 classes each semester in high-demand evening, weekend, hybrid, or accelerated formats. Campus enrollment is typically 4,000 students in a traditional semester, with an average of 170 faculty teaching more than 270 total classes in 40 disciplines each semester.

THE STUDENT SERVICES & LEARNING RESOURCES CENTER

The project is 55,000 square-feet and four stories. It is being built directly to the south of the Science Center and the large, central amphitheater and plaza space. The first floor along Dr. Dianne G. Van Hook Drive features a multipurpose lobby space to flexibly accommodate student services queues, cooperative learning opportunities, and events. The building features 51 offices, 12 workroom/service rooms, seating kiosks, 11 study rooms, 2 classrooms, 1 computer lab, 1 large conference/MPR, and 3 medical lab/exam rooms.

This facility will bookend the completed Science Center and amphitheater and define the heart of the center of campus. The Student Services & Learning Resources Center (alongside the Science Center) adds an additional 110,000 square-feet to the previously 56,000 square-foot campus, dramatically expanding available classroom, lab, and support service space for our students. This is tremendously exciting!

STUDENT SERVICE AND SUPPORT

The Student Services & Learning Resources Center (SSLRC) will be a significant new addition to the Canyon Country Campus, providing a "one-stop" destination for students to receive support and assistance from a full complement of student services offices and programs, in addition to student gathering, meeting, and classroom spaces located in the building. From on-boarding with Admissions and Financial Aid, to student success through Counseling, a robust tutoring center and a variety of student engagement and wellness services, the building will serve as a central hub on campus to ensure student access and success.
