How to Enable Wi-fi Calling on Android Devices

****This feature is available on most new android phones and operating systems. If you do not see the settings below contact your provider for more information****

Step 1: Open the **SETTINGS** menu on your android device and select the **MORE SETTINGS** option underneath wireless and network field.



Step 2: Find the **Wi-Fi Calling** option and move the slider to the **ON** position (as designated by the green slider).



How to Enable Wi-Fi Calling on IOS

****This feature is only available to iPhone 6 or newer models and require IOS 9.0 or higher* ***

Step 1: Navigate to the **SETTINGS** application on your iPhone and select **PHONE**.

Step 2: Within **PHONE** settings select **WI-FI Calling**.



Step 3: Switch the slider to the **ON** position (slider will turn green).

Step 4: A warning about location data being transmitted will appear, select **ENABLE** to finish the set up.
