



SCIENCE CENTER CONSTRUCTION PROGRESS -MARCH 2019 AERIAL

The Canyon Country Campus (CCC) is a vital part of College of the Canyons, providing comprehensive instructional pathways and student services to serve our community. CCC is primed to grow, with planning and construction scheduled for multiple new permanent facilities to transform the campus.

Spring 2019 semester activities and highlights include:

- Celebrating Construction Progress for the long-awaited 55,000 sq. ft. Science Center. This state-of-the-art new facility will house in-demand science laboratory and classroom space for the campus, along with lecture, computer labs, meeting space, and offices. The project is expected to conclude in late-Fall 2019.
- Marking the 12th Spring Semester at the Canyon Country Campus, which opened in August 2007. Following the exciting 10th anniversary year in 17/18 (<u>canyons.edu/ccc10</u>) the campus continues to thrive with emerging pathways and facilities to serve student and community needs.
- **Providing** community and student-centered events, such as the "CCC Patio Talks," "Garden Walks," and "Star Parties" to highlight the expertise of faculty and staff who teach or work at CCC along with relevant campus programs and services.
- Moving forward on facilities projects, including the Science Center and a Student Services & Learning Resources Center along with future projects to serve arts and instructional needs on campus. These projects will expand academic pathways and grow the campus. As a campus, CCC is larger than several CA community colleges.
- Offering approximately 220 class sections this semester, consisting of more than 8,500 seats in 37 different disciplines. More than 100 of these class sections are offered in evening, short-term/accelerated, hybrid, or weekend formats.
- Providing excellent instruction, with 161 faculty teaching at CCC this semester, including approximately 90 who will teach exclusively at CCC during this period.
- Emphasizing student pathways and supportive student services with customized and accelerated educational plans, weekend and evening degree pathways, and increased staffing for student services offices. Future schedules will feature increased accelerated options for the campus.
- **Commemorating the milestone of nearly 8,000 classes offered** since 2007, as well as approx. 60,000 students who have earned credit on campus since that time.
