Do I need a parking permit?

YES! Parking permits will be required after September 2nd, permits may be purchased online through your MyCanyons account or through the Student Business Office at the Valencia Campus (SCOH-101). If you ordered your permit online and have not yet received it, you must pick it up at the Student Business office. Daily permits may be purchased for \$3.00/day from the black vending machines located at the entrance of Lot 2 and in front of the Building 1A in Lot 3.
