## Associated Student Government (ASG)


The [ASG 2021-2022 Application](https://www.canyons.edu/ASG) is now officially LIVE!

**Do you have an immediate question for a counselor?** – Now that summer registration and fall registration dates have been scheduled in your MyCanyons portal, plan ahead. If you are not sure what to register for in the upcoming terms, stop by our Online Express Drop-in Counseling for assistance!

Express Drop-in counseling is an opportunity to meet with a counselor for a short 10 -15-minute consultation to address quick questions. Express Drop-in works on a first come, first serve basis to address questions such as: upcoming registration, adding or dropping classes, grading options, filing a graduation petition, checking progress towards your associate degree or certificate program and/or support with transfer applications. 
