The new Science Building at the Canyon Country Campus continues to take shape, with more cement pours in the past couple of weeks, and good progress within the interior. This exciting, 4-story construction project is visible from most of the campus, and we look forward to ribbon cutting the facili-

ty in late Fall 2019, and opening for student instruction in Spring 2020. The 55,000 square-foot project features 19 classrooms, including 4 state of the art Chemistry labs, 4 Biology labs, lecture and large-lecture rooms, group study and conference space, and offices.
