
Express Drop-In Counseling - This is a short 5 -10 minute session with a counselor designed to support students on a first come, first serve basis to address quick questions such as: Fall registration, adding or dropping classes, grading options, filing a graduation petition, checking progress towards your associate degree or certificate program. The new Science Center building at the Canyon Country campus continues to dazzle, with much of the exterior completed, including windows and exterior finish. The adjacent amphitheater has also taken shape, complete with stairways, trellises, and a large retaining wall in preparation for the next building, the Services/Learning Resources Center (SSLRC). The SSLRC is in the early stages of construction, with grading, heavy equipment, and movement of earth, to form the footprint for this new building that will eventually house the majority of all student support services, in addition to a new library and TLC.
