Counseling

Congratulations on completing the Spring 2020 semester! This has most certainly been the most unusual semester, and you did it! We are so proud of you and your efforts this semester. As you continue on with your academic and career journey at COC in our "new normal", know that we are here to support you with:



Express Drop-In Counseling - this is a short 5 -10 minute session with a counselor designed to support students on a first come, first serve basis, to address quick questions such as: summer registration, adding or dropping classes, grading options, filing a graduation petition, checking progress towards your associate degree or certificate program. To meet with a counselor on Express Drop-In, go to the yellow Drop-In Counseling button at https://www.canyons.edu/student_services/counseling/online/online_dropin.php to sign up! Express drop-in is available Mondays, Wednesday, & Thursday 9 a.m. - 5:30 p.m. Tuesday, 10 a.m. - 6:30 p.m. and Friday, 9 a.m. - 12:30 p.m.

Online Counseling Appointments - these are one hour appointments with a counselor designed for you to address your academic and career goals. Schedule an appointment by visiting our website. Once the appointment is scheduled online, your Counselor will contact you via your MyCanyons email with instructions on how to access the online appointment conducted through Zoom.

E-Advising is also available! E-advising allows you to ask general counseling questions when you don't need an immediate answer. A counselor will email a reply within the same business day.


