Counseling

The Fall 2019 Schedule of classes is now available online and fall registration is right around the corner. If you need help deciding which classes best fit your academic and career goals, meet with a counselor on a drop in counseling basis to help get you started.

Drop-in counseling is a first come, first serve 10-15 minute consultation with a counselor. During drop-in we can help you create a one semester educational plan, clear you for pre-requisites and answer general questions related to your academic and career goals. A counseling appointment is required for a comprehensive student educational plan. We are unable to develop a comprehensive plan on a drop-in basis, however we can certainly discuss classes for fall registration!

Pre-Nursing Advisement Workshop

The Pre-Nursing Advisement Workshop will provide you with an overview of which classes to take in order to prepare for the Associate Degree of Nursing program as well as pre-licensure BSN or RN-BSN programs. It will also go into detail about how to make yourself as competitive as possible, take advantage of volunteer or internship opportunities, TEAS study guide information, and your grades. We will also review the common application timelines for different programs.

- Marked Green curbs are for 30 minute parking only, unless the designated time is posted differently.

Frequently Asked Questions

What support services are available on campus? We provide students with services similar to those offered at the Valencia Campus. For a list of campus support services/departments and hours, check out the support service schedule online at www.canyons.edu/offices/ccc/pages/hours.aspx.

Do I need a parking permit? Student parking permits are required each day. Students must always park in student lots. Permits are available **ONLINE ONLY** through your MyCanyons account located at www.canyons.edu. Daily permits may be purchased for \$3.00/day from the black vending machines.

Where can I print on campus? Printers are available in the Library (307), TLC (306), and Student Study Room (302) for a small fee. Print cards can be purchased in TLC (306) or the Student Study Room (302). Limited **free** printing is available in the Student Services Computer Lab (building 1B). The ASG Student Lounge (204) offers students **15 FREE** Black and White pages as well as **5 free** color pages per day to print out. Color printers are not available in all labs.
