

How to Sign Up for COUN 015

Students on **Academic Probation (A1)** and/or **Progress Probation (P1)** have a registration hold placed on their record. To release the registration hold, students must register and successfully complete the non-credit **NC.COUN-015: Upgrade to Good Academic Standing course**. In this 100% online, week-long course, Counselors will work with students to analyze past academic performance and strengthen individual commitment, motivation, and skills set for future academic success.



The registration hold will be removed for students who pass the class with a 70% or higher. While this course is one week in length, students are not required to wait until the end of the course to get the hold removed. Students have the opportunity to complete the course within a day (approximately 8 hours) and get the hold released by the end of the next business day provided that they complete the coursework by the deadline provided for that day. Details can be found within the policies page of the course orientation module.

It is important that students sign up for this course well before their anticipated upcoming registration date in order to have time to register for classes. The NC.COUN 015 courses are primarily offered during winter and summer intersessions, with only limited offerings during the spring and fall semester.

Here is how you can register for Non-Credit Counseling 015:

Step 1:

Login to My Canyons and select My Registration. Then, click the link that says “Plan, Register, Waitlist, and Drop” from the menu that pops up.



Step 2:

Step 3:


Look for NC.COUN-015 Upgrade to Good Acad. Standing (0 Credits) and click view available sections.


