What is Construction Management?

The Construction Management Technology program is designed to prepare students with the foundation needed to meet the current technological requirements of the construction workplace. Construction Managers plan, organize, schedule, and oversee construction projects from concept to completion. They work with a wide range of construction related professionals including clients, architects, engineers, other contractors, and public officials such as building inspectors. A construction manager may own a construction management or contracting firm or may work as an employee of the owner, developer, contractor, or management firm overseeing the construction project.
