In this session, Dr. Hernandez will provide our campus community members ways to demonstrate strategies on how to make student courses more inclusive for undocumented students. She will engage and explore strategies with syllabi statements, inclusive language, how to include case studies that discuss immigration status to help incorporate into classroom practices. Dr. Hernandez will review various disciplines as examples, as well as discuss ways in which to better support students when they disclose their immigration status in the classroom.

Learning Outcomes:

- Learn various strategies on how to address issues that our undocumented students face;
- Examine the various common stressors (disclosure, financial insecurities, food insecurities, academic distractions, etc.) of our undocumented college students;
- Develop a better understanding of creating classroom/office spaces for all students;
- Enhance and incorporate inclusive language in syllabi statements;
- Assess key findings in a recent study on "Advancing Equity" and how COC can help find solutions
