# **Eligibility Criteria for EOPS/CARE at College of the**

#### **Canyons**

- 1. Enrolled in 12 units minimum (subject to change)
- 2. Be a California resident (AB540 or AB1899)
- 3. Complete Federal Financial Aid App. (FAFSA) or California Dream Act App. (CADAA) OR be eligible for the California College Promise Grant (CCPG/BOG) Income Standards under Method A or B
- 4. Completed fewer than 65 degree applicable units from all colleges/universities attended
- 5. Have an educational need in ONE of the following areas:
  - Not recommended to enroll in degree applicable English or Math classes
  - Does not have a high school diploma or GED
  - High School G.P.A. below 2.5
  - Previously enrolled in remedial English or Math classes
  - Be a current or former foster youth
  - Be a first-generation college student
  - Be a non-native English speaker

- Our Fall 2021 registration cycle is starting MUCH EARLIER than in prior years and will continue this way for future terms.
- Apply for EOPS/CARE ASAP in order to benefit from our priority registration so you can get the classes you need!
