Temporary Evidence of Lawful Admission for Permanent Residence"; or Visa in an unexpired foreign passport with a U.S. Customs and Border Protection (CBP) inspector admission stamp and the statement "UPON ENDORSEMENT SERVES AS TEMPORARY I-551 EVIDENCING PERMANENT RESIDENCE FOR 1 YEAR"; or U.S. Travel Document (form I-327) with stamp "Permit to Reenter".										
Refugee	Departure Record (Form I-94A) or Arrival Departure Record (Form I-94) with stamp showing admission as refugee under Section 207 of the Immigration and Nationality Act (INA) or "209a pending. Employment Authorized"; or U.S Travel Document (Form I-571) with stamp "Permit to Reenter."										
Asylee	Departure Record (Form I-94A) or Arrival Departure Record (Form I-94) with stamp showing admission as asylee under Section 208 of the Immigration and Nationality Act (INA) or "209b pending. Employment Authorized"; or U.S Travel Document (Form I-571) with stamp "Permit to Reenter."										
Parolee	Departure Record (Form I-94A) or Arrival Departure Record (Form I-94) with stamp indicating "Alien paroled into the U.S. pursuant to Section 212(d)(5)" <u>and Notice of Action (Form I-797)</u> .										
Victim of Human Trafficking or Spouse, Child or Parent of Victim	Victim must submit certification letter from the Department of Health and Human Services (HHS). Spouse, child or parent of victim must submit a copy of the victim's certification letter and a copy of their T-visa.
