Please review all of the scholarship descriptions and their designated cycle on the following two pages.

Applicants must meet the highly competitive selection criteria including the ability to articulate a clear statement of goals, the likelihood of goal attainment, demonstration of personal courage & commitment, and financial need.

Applications can be typed or handwritten on single sided pages. Please do not write or type on both sides of a sheet. Applicants are welcome to apply during the following two cycles:

- 1st CYCLE (Applications Accepted Feb. 1 May 1)
- 2nd CYCLE (Applications Accepted Aug. 1 Nov. 1)

You MUST select at least ONE, and you MAY select up to TWO scholarships per cycle.

NOTIFICATION PROCESS:

Applicants will be notified of the award decisions by **JUNE 30TH** for the 1st cycle and **DECEMBER 31st** for the 2nd cycle.

Please do not call regarding the status of your application—you will be notified of the award decisions within the notification periods.



1st CYCLE – Applications accepted FEBRUARY 1 through MAY 1.

\$1,000.00 - THE SINGERMAN - NOSSECK CHILDCARE SCHOLARSHIP

To qualify, an applicant must be entering or continuing school in an accredited institution in order to learn a marketable skill, which will lead to economic self-sufficiency. The award is not restricted to any field or academic program, as the award is intended to ease the financial burden of childcare for a parent in school.

\$1,000.00 - SOPHIE GREENSTADT SCHOLARSHIP FOR MID-LIFE WOMEN

To qualify, an applicant must be re-entering or continuing school in order to learn a marketable skill which will lead to economic self-sufficiency. The applicant must be a woman **35** years of age or older for whom the opportunity to return to school will lead to economic independence. The applicant can be either married or single, with or without children.

\$1,000.00 - THE DODELL WOMEN'S EMPOWERMENT SCHOLARSHIP

To qualify, an applicant must be re-entering or continuing school in order to learn a marketable skill which will lead to economic self-sufficiency. The applicant must be a woman **25** years of age or older for whom the opportunity to return to school will lead to economic independence. The applicant can be either married or single, with or without children.

\$1,000.00 - SUSAN SCHULMAN BEGLEY MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

This award is given to a woman who is establishing herself as a head of household and a single parent, and due to extreme circumstances *following the dissolution of an abusive or emotionally traumatic relationship* has no other adequate financial means, and requires funds to meet immediate needs for herself and her children, including rent & food.

\$2,000.00 - INGER LAWRENCE-M.R. BAUER FOUNDATION NURSING STUDIES SCHOLARSHIP

This award is given to woman or man enrolled in or accepted to a degree program in nursing. Some units toward the degree are preferred, but not required.

\$2,000.00 – THE JUNE MILLER NURSING EDUCATION SCHOLARSHIP

This award is given to woman or man enrolled in or accepted to a degree program in nursing. Some units toward the degree are preferred, but not required.

\$2,000.00 - THE SHERMAN & FRANCES L. TELLER TEACHING CREDENTIAL SCHOLARSHIP

To qualify a candidate must be a K-12 educator pursuing a multiple or single subject TEACHING CREDENTIAL (includes special education and ESL). The applicant must be enrolled at a University of California or California State University campus in the greater Los Angeles area. The applicant may be a man OR woman.

\$1,000.00 - STEPHEN L. TELLER & RICHARD HOTSON TV, CINEMA, AND THEATER SCHOLARSHIP

To qualify, an applicant must be a full-time student enrolled in a COMMUNITY COLLEGE Film/ Television/ Cinema/ Theater program, and preparing for a career in film, television, or theater production (not acting). Applicant must have completed 12 units of classes in their school's Film/TV/Cinema/Theater program.



2nd CYCLE - Applications accepted AUGUST 1 – NOVEMBER 1.

\$1,000.00 - THE SINGERMAN - NOSSECK CHILDCARE SCHOLARSHIP

To qualify, an applicant must be entering or continuing school in an accredited institution in order to learn a marketable skill, which will lead to economic self-sufficiency. The award is not restricted to any field or academic program, as the award is intended to ease the financial burden of childcare for a parent in school.

\$1,000.00 - SOPHIE GREENSTADT SCHOLARSHIP FOR MID-LIFE WOMEN

To qualify, an applicant must be re-entering or continuing school in order to learn a marketable skill which will lead to economic self-sufficiency. The applicant must be a woman **35** years of age or older for whom the opportunity to return to school will lead to economic independence. The applicant can be either married or single, with or without children.

\$1,000.00 - THE DODELL WOMEN'S EMPOWERMENT SCHOLARSHIP

To qualify, an applicant must be re-entering or continuing school in order to learn a marketable skill which will lead to economic self-sufficiency. The applicant must be a woman **25** years of age or older for whom the opportunity to return to school will lead to economic independence. The applicant can be either married or single, with or without children.

\$1,000.00 - SYLVIA & SAMUEL SCHULMAN MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

To qualify, an applicant must be a **single mother** entering or continuing school in an accredited institution in order to learn a marketable skill, which will lead to economic independence. The award is made in two payments of \$500.00. The second payment will be received after written confirmation of status and current school transcripts from the recipient.

\$2,000.00 - INGER LAWRENCE-M.R. BAUER FOUNDATION NURSING STUDIES SCHOLARSHIP

This award is given to woman or man enrolled in or accepted to a degree program in nursing. Some units toward the degree are preferred, but not required.

\$2,000.00 - THE JUNE MILLER NURSING EDUCATION SCHOLARSHIP

This award is given to woman or man enrolled in or accepted to a degree program in nursing. Some units toward the degree are preferred, but not required.

\$2,000.00 - THE SHERMAN & FRANCES L. TELLER TEACHING CREDENTIAL SCHOLARSHIP

To qualify a candidate must be a K-12 educator pursuing a multiple or single subject TEACHING CREDENTIAL (includes special education and ESL). The applicant must be enrolled at a University of California or California State University campus in the greater Los Angeles area. The applicant may be a man OR woman.

\$1,000.00 - STEPHEN L. TELLER & RICHARD HOTSON TV, CINEMA, AND THEATER SCHOLARSHIP

To qualify, an applicant must be a full-time student enrolled in a COMMUNITY COLLEGE Film/ Television/ Cinema/ Theater program, and preparing for a career in film, television, or theater production (not acting). Applicant must have completed 12 units of classes in their school's Film/TV/Cinema/Theater program.

If you received a scholarship from NCJW I LA in a previous cycle, please include an update on your academic progress since receiving the scholarship. (Please re-read the description of the scholarship(s) you are applying for and demonstrate that you fit the specific eligibility criteria listed for each of them).
