ASG Elections Committee Chair, Ellie Wingo, and ASG Advisor, Lynn Suh, drafted two options to present to the Senate. The Senate will provide input on which change should be implemented for the second reading of the Election Code. 1st reading language: Candidates for President, Executive Vice President, and Student Trustee previously must have been a part of COC's ASG as an officer. Option 1: Candidates for President and Executive Vice President must have completed at least 20 semester units at COC. Option 2: Candidates for President, Executive Vice President, and Student Trustee must have completed at least 20 semester units at COC. Candidates for President, Executive Vice President, and Student Trustee must submit a Letter of Recommendation written by an individual (excluding family and friends) that can speak on the candidate's leadership skills. Candidates will input the recommender's information (name, phone number, and e-mail address) in their Candidate Application. An e-mail with instructions will be sent to the recommender to submit a letter of recommendation by April 8, 2024, at 11:59pm. Letters of recommendation for candidates will be posted alongside the candidate's platform statement without revealing the identity of the recommender.
