The Crime and Intelligence Analysis Certificate (CIAC) prepares students for an entry level position as a crime or intelligence analyst and certification as an analyst under the International Association of Crime Analysts (IACA).

This program has a twofold focus (1) analysis and crime trends most commonly encountered by patrol officers and investigators such as murder, aggravated assault, rape, robbery, burglary, and theft, and (2) crimes investigated by intelligence officers such as criminal networks, organized crime groups, narcotics, gangs, smuggling, trafficking, pirated goods, money laundering, and other illicit rings.

Submit an application for admission

- Go to: www.canyons.edu/freeclasses

- Successful application submission will generate an email with the subject line, "Your COC Noncredit Application Has Been Accepted." The email will also include your unique student email, which is also your CanyonsID username.
