



Bylaws Update: Personal Significant Gift

Amended and Restated Bylaws

Article 4

### **BOARD OF DIRECTORS**

Section 4

Section 4.11. Personally Significant Gift

The Foundation aims for 100% participation in board member giving. Beginning in the 2025–2026 fiscal year, new directors are expected to contribute a minimum of two thousand five hundred dollars (\$2,500) annually. Up to fifty percent of a director's personally significant gift may be fulfilled through accepted contributions.

Directors installed prior to July 2025 and in good standing may continue to fulfill their annual commitment at a reduced amount of fifteen hundred dollars (\$1,500) per year or via a fundraising "get" until June 2027. While the Foundation is grateful for all contributions, directors are encouraged to make a personally significant gift above the minimum if they are able.

At the discretion of the Executive Director and Chief Development Officer, the Foundation may confidentially offer a reduced annual giving threshold of fifteen hundred dollars (\$1,500) to directors who are in good standing with respect to participation and giving. This exception may be extended to no more than ten percent of the total board membership.

Additionally, two members of the Young Professional Committee may serve as Junior Directors, with a minimum annual gift of fifteen hundred dollars (\$1,500).

Beyond their personal contributions, directors are also expected to support fundraising efforts at the committee level. The fundraising committee will determine the "Get" threshold based on its specific goals.
