If you dropped a course during the Spring semester before the refund deadline, don't forget to request your refund if you haven't already. 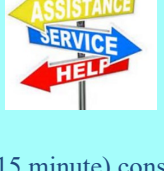

Need a hand? The CCC Library team is ready to assist!

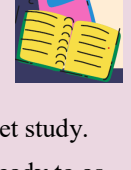
Our welcoming space offers 13 computer stations and 7 study rooms, perfect for group projects or quiet study.
