Graduation Petition Deadlines:

Are you completing your associate's degree this year? If so, be sure to file your graduation petition before the deadline.

-Fall 2025: September 26th

-Spring 2026: March 13th

NOTE: *File your Spring 2026 graduation petition by the end of September 2025 to be eligible for a graduating student priority registration date for Spring 2026. October 6th, fall registration dates will be available through your MyCanyons.*

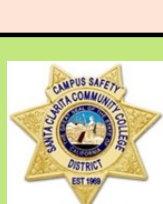
