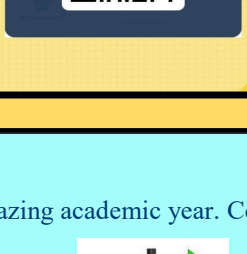
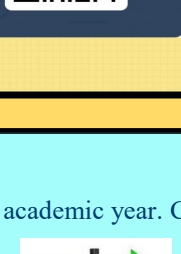

Fall 2026: September 28, 2026

*Spring 2027: March 12, 2027

*File your spring graduation petition by early October to qualify for a priority graduating student spring registration date. Spring registration dates will be assigned by October 19th.

Meet with a counselor on Express Drop-in to complete your graduation petition! If you have taken classes at another college, schedule a one-hour counseling appointment to have your transcripts evaluated!

Campus Safety is located in Quad 5, Room 511 at the north end of campus.

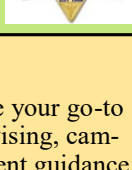
