Spring Parking Permits

Spring parking permits are now available. Students may log in to their MyCanyons account and select the blue **Parking** icon to purchase a permit. Please be prepared to verify your vehicle information, including license plate number, color, make, and model. If you choose to purchase a parking permit in person, please note that we accept **cash only**.

Refund Information

All refunds are issued at the end of each semester for classes dropped **before** the refund deadline. A **Refund Request** button is now available on the Student Business Office website, which will direct you straight to the request form.

1098-T Tax Forms

As tax season approaches, **1098-T forms are available as of January 31st**. Students may view or print their 1098-T by logging into their **MyCanyons** account and navigating to:

Student Account → View My 1098-T Form

Please note that all 1098-T forms will be submitted to the IRS by **March 1, 2026**, after which no further corrections can be made. Students are strongly encouraged to review their information in MyCanyons and ensure the following:

- Your **legal name** matches your Social Security card
- Your **SSN or ITIN** is accurate
- Your **address** is current
