Counseling

Congratulations to all our graduates and welcome to our new incoming students! The Counseling Office is here to support you with your academic, career, and transfer goals.

In-Person Office Hours:

In-Person Express Drop-in Counseling Hours:

Monday & Tuesday: 2:00 p.m. - 4:30 p.m.

Express Drop-in Counseling works on a first come, first serve basis. No appointment is needed.

Graduation Petition Deadlines:

Summer 2025: July 11th; Fall 2025: September 26th; Spring 2026: March 13th

NOTE: File your Spring 2026 graduation petition by the end of September 2025 to be eligible for a graduating student priority registration date for Spring 2026. October 6th, fall registration dates will be available through MyCanyons.

Counseling Workshops:

We offer a variety of workshops to support new, continuing and returning students. Some workshops include:

Getting Started Workshops are held every Wednesday from 1-3:30 p.m. at the Canyon Country Campus & every Tuesday from 2-4:30 p.m. at the Valencia campus.

This workshop is designed for NEW STUDENTS with or without external transcripts. The last 30 minutes is an open lab for questions and/or completion of a first-semester education plan.

Pre-Nursing Advisement Workshops

Provides an overview of classes to take to prepare for the Associate Degree of Nursing program as well as pre-licensure BSN or RN-BSN programs. Will review how to make yourself as competitive as possible, take advantage of volunteer/internship opportunities, TEAS study guide information, and your grades. Everything Transfer Open Labs every Tuesday from 11:00 am. - 1:00 p.m.

Open labs are available to assist you with your transfer applications. A counselor is available to review your questions.

Health Professions Workshop:

Choose Your Major Workshops from 11:30 a.m. – 12:30 p.m. every Wednesday online

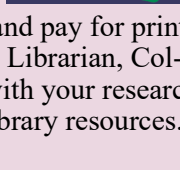
