Summer Tuition Deadline Reminder:

Please be advised that all summer semester tuition and fees must be paid by **June 26, 2026**. Any unpaid balances after this deadline may result in a hold being placed on your student account.

If you need assistance regarding your balance, payment options, or account status, please contact the Student Business Office by phone, email, or by visiting us in person. Our staff are always happy to help.

Students who dropped a spring semester course prior to the refund deadline should verify that their refund request has been submitted, if applicable. Refunds are issued according to the original payment method and may be processed either back to the payment card used or by mailed check. Eligible refunds are automatically processed at the end of each semester.

Financial Aid

2026-2027 FAFSA Update
 Students who have already submitted their 2026-2027 FAFSA application may not see it reflected in their MyCanyons portal yet. Financial Aid processing for the upcoming academic year is expected to begin again around June 1st.

In the meantime, we recommend students double-check the following:
 • Make sure College of the Canyons is listed on your 2026-2027 FAFSA application
 • Confirm that your correct Social Security Number is on file with Admissions & Records at COC, as this is how your FAFSA is matched to your student account

At this time, no further action is needed if your FAFSA has already been submitted. Students should continue monitoring their MyCanyons portal for updates regarding financial aid status and eligibility.

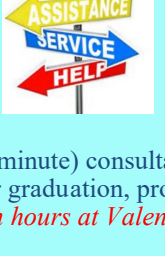

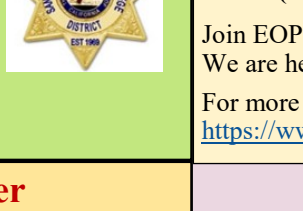
- Stay hydrated and remember to rest and get out of the heat on hot days.
