**Hello Cougars,**

We hope your Fall 2025 semester is off to a great start. Before we all shift into full pumpkin spice mode, the Student Business Office would like to share a few important reminders to help keep you on track this academic year.

First, please remember that to be eligible for a refund, you must drop your classes **before the refund deadline**. Refunds are not issued for classes dropped after this deadline, so it's important to check the schedule and make any changes early.

Next, please be aware that **holds will be placed on all unpaid accounts** beginning on the following dates: for Fall 2025, holds begin on **Thursday, September 18, 2025**; for Winter 2026, holds begin on **Thursday, March 19, 2026**; and for Spring 2026, holds will also begin on **Thursday, March 19, 2026**. A hold may impact your ability to register for future semesters, so we encourage you to settle any outstanding balances before these deadlines.

Refunds are automatically processed and sent out at the **end of each semester**. However, if you would like to receive your refund sooner, you may request one online through your **My Canyons Portal**. This is a quick and convenient way to expedite the refund process.
